Quarry Bank Mill was founded in 1784. On this trip, you'll be able to explore the workings of a Victorian Cotton Mill, experience the tranquility of Quarry Bank House, see how Victorian workers lived their lives and enjoy the sights and sounds that the beautiful gardens have to offer.

Experience heritage machinery at work in the mill: You can feel the floors shake with the power of the spinning machines and hear the clatter of the weaving looms at work.

Please note there are steep and rugged paths on the site. There is a shuttle buggy service for those with accessibility needs.
